"Swayamsevaks Become 'Sewadoots'" in the Natural Calamity in Himachal Pradesh

The devastating floods in Himachal Pradesh have severely disrupted lives. Hundreds of families have become homeless, many villages have been completely destroyed, and people are left without food, clothing, or medicines.

With the support of Karyakartas and Rashtriya Sewa Bharati, Sewa Bharati Karyakartas are providing essential supplies like food, clothing, medicines, and shelter to the affected families.

As every year, this year too, sewa activities were organized by Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh through Utkal Bipanna Sahayata Samiti (Sewa Bharati) during the Puri Rath Yatra. A total of 9 types of service activities were carried out, inaugurated at the Primary Health Centre near Bholanath Vidyalaya. On this occasion, Eastern Kshetra Pracharak Shri Jagdish Prasad Kharanga, Kshetra Sampark Pramukh Shri Vidyut Mukherjee, VHP President Shri Praful Kumar Mishra, and Committee President Shri Akshay Kumar Bit were present.

The sewa included: transporting injured or unconscious devotees to hospitals, creating ambulance corridors, stretcher sewa, water distribution, water spraying, hospital sewa, first aid, traffic management, and general sanitation.

A total of 1560 Karyakartas were deployed: 20 for 2 ambulances, 25 at 5 water distribution points 40 for 10 water sprayers, 80 for stretcher sewa, 200 at 2 medical centers, 200 for general cleaning 11 for first aid, 100 for traffic services, 884 for ambulance corridors, in addition, 5 doctors and 2 pharmacists were engaged in sewa.

On the day of the Rath Yatra, 750 devotees received first aid. These sewa were supervised by senior karyakartas of the Sangh and committee coordinators. The sewa will continue throughout the festival period. Other contributing organizations included VHP, ABVP, Hindu Jagran Manch, Bharatiya Mazdoor Sangh, and Bharat Vikas Parishad.

Two-Day Vaibhavshree Study Volunteer Training Camp

Under the aegis of Rashtriya Sewa Bharati, a two-day training camp for Vaibhavshree Study Teams from Bihar, Jharkhand, Odisha, Bengal, and Assam prants was organized on 14–15 June 2025 at Seva Dham, Jonha, Ranchi.

The camp was inaugurated by Joint General Secretary of Rashtriya Sewa Bharati Shri Vijay Puranik ji, Trustees Shri Gurusharan Prasad ji, Shri Manoj Chatterjee ji, and Shri Padma Kumar ji by lighting the ceremonial lamp.

Women associated with Vaibhavshree are playing a vital role in eliminating social evils. Vaibhavshree is a medium of social transformation. Alongside economic empowerment, overall empowerment of women is essential.

The training camp focused on the concept and organizational structure of Vaibhavshree. Emphasis was laid on linking self-help groups to self-employment schemes and integrating these into their lives. Participants visited four running SHGs in Angara block and gained field experience.


