AKHIL BHARATIYA PRACHAR VIBHAG PRASHIKSHAN VARG



A two-day Akhil Bharatiya Prachar Vibhag Prashikshan Varg was organized by Rashtriya Sewa Bharati on 13-14 September 2025 at Shri Muktinath Ved Vidyashram (Sanskrit Gurukul), Shri Mata Mansadevi Complex, Sector-4, Panchkula, Haryana. In the inaugural session, the chief guests were Shri Pradeep ji (Sah Prachar Pramukh, RSS), Dr. Ram Kumar ji (Mantri, Rashtriya Sewa Bharati), and Acharya Swami Prasad Mishra ji (Founder and Director, Sanskrit Gurukul).

Prant: Jodhpur

Akhil Bharatiya Chhatrawas Karyakarta Prashikshan Varg 2025

Venue: Badri Palace, Jodhpur | Dates: 18–21 September 2025



Organized by Rashtriya Sewa Bharati, the four-day varg saw 100 karyakartas from 11 regions and 33 prants participating from across the country.

The objective was to empower hostel karyakartas with a unified disha, drishti, and karyapaddhati.
