A Comprehensive Health Service Campaign on National Youth Day

On the auspicious occasion of National Youth Day, Sewa Bharati, Dakshin Bihar Prant, conducted a large-scale health service campaign in service settlements. With the objective of ensuring medical access to underprivileged and needy sections of society, 357 free medical check-up camps were organized.



A total of 418 doctors dedicated their time in the spirit of service. They were supported by 1,214 medical students and 1,322 local volunteers who actively contributed to the initiative.



Through this coordinated effort, 24,982 citizens received free health check-ups, consultation, and necessary guidance.

This campaign extended beyond treatment—it strengthened health awareness, youth participation, and service values within society. Sewa Bharati's initiative on National Youth Day demonstrates that when organized youth power reaches the last person in society, the path of transformation creates itself.

Prant: Kerala

Sewa Bharati Kerala, in collaboration with NDRF, organized a disaster management training at Saraswati Vidyaniketan, Thrissur. Under the leadership of Inspector S. P. Singh, the team provided practical training in CPR, rescue techniques, and disaster equipment handling to 50 service volunteers.

The training enabled volunteers to respond swiftly and effectively during emergencies. The NDRF team was honored at the conclusion of the program. This initiative proved inspiring and highly beneficial in strengthening community safety.



Prant: Vidarbha

The Annual Sneh Milan of girls from 16 Kishori Vikas Kendras was enthusiastically organized at Sewa Sadan School, Nagpur. The program began with Deep Prajwalan and Bharat Mata Pujan.

Guidance was provided on values, Swadeshi, civic duties, physical and mental changes during adolescence, and balanced nutrition. The girls showcased their talent and confidence through Surya Namaskar, Karate, and performances based on women empowerment, environmental protection, water conservation, patriotism, and social awareness.

A painting competition on the theme "Panchsutri" was organized, and winners were honored. The presence of key workers, service-minded parents, and guests added inspiration to the event.



Prant: Jammu & Kashmir

A seven-day residential Swadhyaya Shivar was organized in Nagrota, Jammu & Kashmir. A total of 104 students from Sewa Bharati hostels in Bani, Katra, Chandigarh, Pounichak (Jammu), and Rajouri participated with the support of nearly 40 volunteers. The camp focused on academic strengthening, disciplined living, physical fitness, value-based education, and national awareness.

On the inaugural occasion, Akhil Bharatiya Chhatravas Pramukh Shri Jaydev Dada Ji and Prant Pracharak Shri Mukesh Kumar Ji emphasized the importance of self-study, discipline, and moral values. Various administrative and public representatives also encouraged the students.

The camp included daily exercise, study sessions, Seva-Bhav dialogues, inspirational film screenings, cultural programs, and educational visits. The students' talent, discipline, and confidence were especially appreciated.

Prant: Uttarakhand

On the occasion of Sangh Shatabdi Year, Sewa Bharati Uttarakhand (District Haldwani) organized 10 free health camps. A total of 1,122 patients received free health check-ups and consultations. The initiative saw participation from 39 doctors, 27 medical students, 23 paramedical staff, 174 volunteers, and 37 guests.



Prant: Malwa

At Sewa Bharati's medical project at M.Y. Hospital, Indore, around 130 students from Acropolis College undertook a Project Darshan. Students were informed how Sewa Bharati volunteers guide needy patients—often unfamiliar with complex hospital procedures—toward timely treatment. The visit included observation of Sahara Ward, OPD, Artificial Limb Department, Blood Bank, Medicine, and Surgical Departments. Notably, 11 students voluntarily donated blood, translating service spirit into action.



Prant: Braj

A training session was conducted for Presidents, Mantri, and Koshadhyaksha from 19 districts of Agra Division. The upcoming action plan was discussed in detail. In the presence of Rashtriya Sewa Bharati Mantri Ramkumar Ji and senior Prant and Vibhag office bearers, 52 volunteers participated. The training proved to be an important step toward organizational strengthening and expansion of service activities.

In Raisen Nagar, Nayapura, around 100 adolescent girls participated enthusiastically in a Kishori Personality Development Camp. Sessions focused on self-confidence, values, and self-defense. The strong presence of Matrushakti gave the event the form of a collective family and social resolve. The camp proved to be a strong step toward women empowerment.

Prant: Chittor

A 10-day free Ayurveda Ksharsutra surgical camp was organized in Udaipur under the joint aegis of the Ayurveda Department and National AYUSH Mission. A total of 19,338 patients benefited from Ayurvedic treatment, including 102 admitted patients who underwent special surgical procedures including Ksharsutra. Significant success was achieved in cases of piles, fistula, and other anorectal diseases.

In the Panchakarma Department, 922 patients received treatment, and 3,550 children were administered Swarna Prashan. Patients were provided medicine kits and pathya-apathya guidance at the conclusion of the camp.



Prant: Delhi

A Thalassemia screening drive and blood donation camp was organized at Keshav Puram, Delhi.

Sewa Bharati Diagnostic & Dialysis Center conducted free Thalassemia tests for 26 beneficiaries. The campaign strengthened health awareness and the spirit of humanitarian service.

A Yuva Abhyuday Program was organized in Bhopal with the objective of awakening service spirit, national consciousness, and leadership qualities among youth.


Prant: Kerala

The hostel not only provides education but also instills confidence, discipline, and Seva-Bhav. Through sports, computer education, skill training, and social engagement, the girls become self-reliant and responsible citizens.

This is not merely a building—it is a school of dreams blossoming on the soil of struggle, where every daughter learns to carve her identity even through the hardest stone.
